I am getting an qEEG!

1. Today I am getting a qEEG, which stands for quantitative electroencephalogram. Although this sounds complicated, this test is simple and safe. I am getting a qEEG is so that the doctor can see how my brain is working!



2. A nurse will then ask me to sit in a chair. While the nurse is setting up, I can watch a video or talk to my parents!



3. A hat will then be placed on my head; this looks a lot like a swim cap! This hat has little holes in it which will then be filled with a cold gel. I might feel the gel on my scalp, but it will not hurt me! Along with the gel the nurse will place little clamps onto my ear lobes.



4. It is important that I stay as still as I can during this test. I will be asked to follow some instructions during the test. I will do my best to follow the instructions!



5.. Once the test is over, the nurse will remove the cap from my head. Since everyone is so proud of me, I will get a lollipop and a sticker!
