



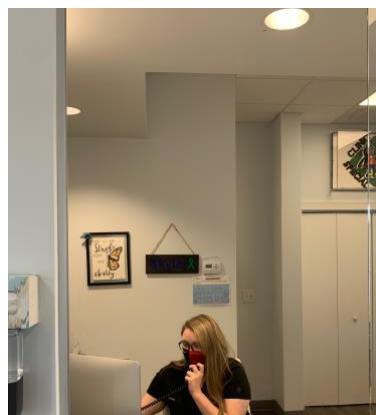
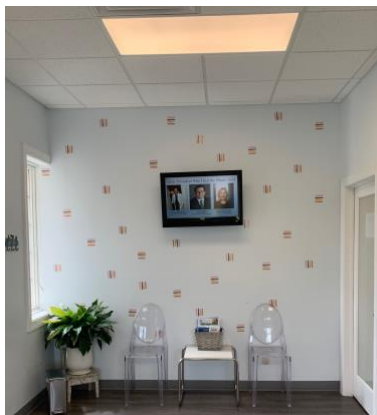

I am going to see the doctor!

1. I am going to see the doctor today! To get to the office I must go on a fun ride on the elevator.



2. In the waiting room, someone at the front desk will greet me and check me in. Then I will wait patiently until the doctor is ready to see me. While I wait, I can play, read, or color.



3. A nurse will then take my vitals. I will step on the scale so she can see how much I've grown! She may ask to take my blood pressure. To take my blood pressure a band will be wrapped around my arm. I might feel a little squeeze, but this will not hurt me.



4. Next, the doctor will come in the room to see me. The doctor will ask me and my parents questions about my health. I will try my best to answer the doctor's questions.



5. The doctor may need to look at my body, this is called a physical examination. The doctor will use a special type of flashlight to look in my ears, nose, and mouth. I will need to sit still and may need to stick out my tongue and say "AHHH".



6. Sometimes the doctor needs to learn more about my body. The doctor may need to get swab the inside of my cheek with a cotton swab, it's a lot like brushing my teeth.



7. Once we are done, I will get a lollipop and/or sticker from the front desk. I am proud of myself and everyone is proud of me!
