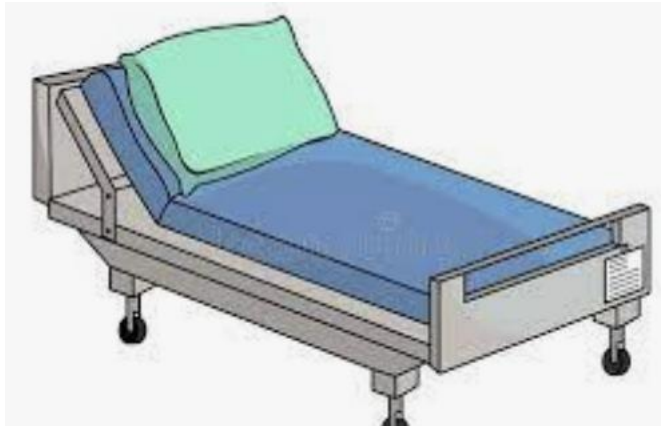




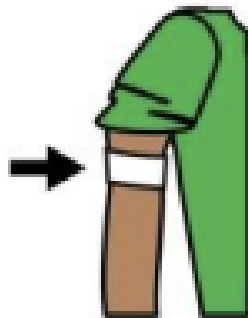

I am Going to Have a Blood Draw!

1. I am going to have a blood draw at the Clinic for Special Children. First, I will sit on a table that looks like this. The doctor will then look at my arms and feet for a healthy vein, using a finger.



2. A blue band will be wrapped around my arm. This might feel like a tight hug on my arm. A buzzy bee may also be wrapped around my arm.



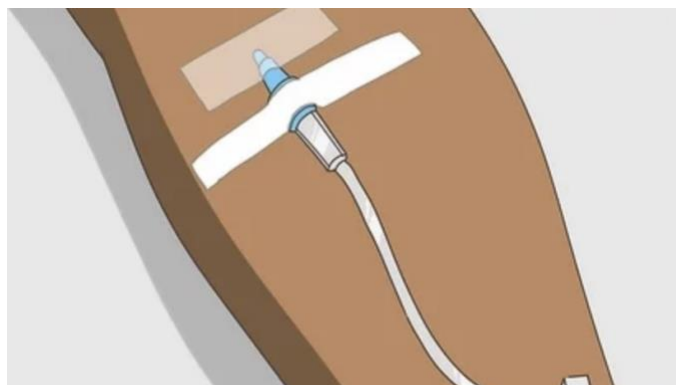
3. The nurse will use a cold wipe to clean my skin. This will not be painful. Next, the doctor will spray cold spray onto my arm, we call this popsicle spray!



4. , I can watch a video, talk to my parents about my favorite things or plans for the day so I don't have to watch the next step. Sometimes, mom or dad may give me a big hug to help me stay still.



5. Now this is the part when I need to be brave! A nurse or helper may hold my arm still while the doctor presses on my arm. I may feel a little pinch, but I am safe. The doctor needs to take some of my blood to keep me healthy and happy.



6. I am finished! The doctor will put on a band-aid or a blue wrap over a piece of cotton. Because I was so brave, I will receive a lollipop and sticker!



Let's keep the band-aid for a few minutes!
